

The following rules have been designed for the safety and enjoyment of all our campers while visiting Whitetail Bluff.

To ensure that everyone has a good time, we must be respectful of others and use common sense. Follow all rules posted at activity areas.

### **GENERAL**

- 1. All visitors must stop and register at the office before entering the Campground.
- 2. You must be 21 years old to make a reservation. Cabins you must be 25 years old.
- 3. You must be 21 years old to consume alcohol. Underage drinkers will be asked to leave.
- 4. Smoking is not allowed in any Campground buildings, at the beach, pool or playground areas. Must be 18 years and older to smoke.
- 5. Check in time is at 2:00 PM and check out time is at 12:00 PM. Weekend reservations are a 2 night stay minimum and Holidays are a 3 night stay minimum.
- 6. The speed limit at the Campground is 5 MPH.
- 7. Enforced quiet time is 11:00 PM to 8:00 AM. Loud music and excessive noise will not be tolerated at any time of day or night.
- 8. Only one vehicle parked in parking area per campsite, unless approved by Management.
- 9. All golf carts, bicycles and pedestrians are to use the roadways. Please do not cut through the sites of others. Be respectful.
- 10. Fireworks, Firearms, and Explosives are not allowed in the Campground.
- 11. Use of ATV's, UTV's and dirt bikes are only allowed if going to and from the trails off the Campground. They are **NOT** allowed to be used as transportation around the Campground.
- 12. The Campground is **NOT** responsible for any accidents or injuries to our guests, nor the loss of money or valuables of any kind.
- 13. All reservations are NON-REFUNDABLE!

# <u>PETS</u>

- 1. All pets must be kept on a leash at all times.
- 2. All pet feces must be cleaned up immediately by the owner.
- 3. Pets must be quiet and non-aggressive. Any pet that causes a disturbance or endangers others must be removed from the property immediately. We may call animal control if necessary.
- 4. Campers must bring proof of rabies vaccination.
- 5. Pets are **NOT** allowed in the Cabins, Campground activity areas, or in any Campground buildings.
- 6. We allow **NO** more than 2 pets total (cat or dog). No birds, rodents, rabbits, farm animals, or exotic animals.
- 7. No animals left unattended at your camp site-no boarding.

### **CHILDREN**

- 1. Parents are responsible for the actions and safety of their children.
- 2. No rock or sand throwing anywhere in the Campground.
- 3. Children under 14 must at all times be supervised and accompanied at the Campground activity areas; Pond, Beach, Pool, Jumping Pillow, and Playground. Day visitors must be 16 or accompanied by an adult.
- 4. Children must be at a campsite by 9:00 PM and need to be supervised there.
- 5. No bicycling after dusk.

#### POND, BEACH AREA, POOL & TRAILS

- 1. Pond, Beach, Pool, and Trails close at dusk and remain closed while dark.
- 2. Wristbands are required and available for purchase at Clubhouse. Wristbands **MUST** remain on and be visible during time on inflatables.
- 3. Swimming diapers are required for toddlers wearing diapers.
- 4. No glass allowed on the beach or near the pond or pool.
- 5. No pets allowed on the beach or in the pond or pool.
- 6. No rock or sand throwing.
- 7. No fishing, there's no fish in the pond.
- 8. You are responsible for your own trash, pick-up after yourself.
- 9. NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. Swimming is always at your own risk, and children under 16 years old must be accompanied by an adult.
- 10. No horseplay allowed.

### POND INFLATABLES

- 1. Proper swim attire **MUST** be worn at all times; no denim, belts, cutoffs, sweats, cargo shorts, or any other street wear.
- 2. Wristbands are required and available for purchase at Clubhouse. Wristbands **MUST** remain on and be visible during time on inflatables.
- 3. Please remove watches, jewelry, earrings (piercings or similar items), when using inflatables.
- 4. All activities are at your **own risk.** This is not a guarded site.
- 5. NO head first / backwards down the slides.
- 6. **NO** running, diving, rough housing, or pushing.
- 7. NO diving, flipping, or jumping off inflatables. Do not swim under inflatables.
- 8. Guests are to demonstrate "family environment" behavior, including language.
- 9. Violating any of the rules may result in being expelled from inflatables.
- 10. Inflatable users will be held responsible for any damages they cause to inflatables.

#### JUMPING PILLOW

- 1. No flipping off Jumping Pillow.
- 2. No jumping on Jumping Pillow when wet or deflated.
- 3. Remove footwear, jewelry, and empty pockets.
- 4. No sharp objects while on Jumping Pillow.
- 5. No food or drink while on Jumping Pillow.
- 6. No throwing sand on Jumping Pillow.

### **FIRES**

- 1. Do not remove fire rings.
- 2. Only burn firewood in your fire ring.
- 3. Do **NOT** bring outside firewood into the campground. Firewood must be purchased from Whitetail Bluff to keep tree pests and diseases from spreading in our area.
- 4. Fires must always be attended by an adult and kept lower than knee high.
- 5. Fires must be extinguished before abandoning. Extinguish fires before going to bed.
- 6. Do not walk through anyone's campsite. Fire pit injuries can be serious.
- 7. Keep your fire pit clean. Please recycle and dispose of garbage.

### GARBAGE

- 1. Please separate garbage & recycle in the appropriate locations. Cans should be bagged and placed in fenced area next to dumpster.
- 2. All garbage is to be placed in garbage bags and put in the dumpster located near the exit of Campground.
- The dumpster is only for disposing of bagged Campground trash. Do not throw away large items or electronics.
  Fees will be imposed for not following this rule.
- 4. Campsites must be kept clean and uncluttered.

# **CAMPING UNITS**

- 1. Never dump any wastewater directly on the ground. Law requires grey water to be disposed of at the dumping station.
- 2. Be sure to have your camping unit properly hooked up to the septic or dumping station.
- 3. Do **NOT** place any wipes, paper towels or tampons in the holding tank or waste system. Septic systems cannot tolerate these items.

### PARKING

- 1. Boats and boat trailers are not allowed to be parked at your campsite. Please ask in Clubhouse for other parking spots available.
- 2. Each campsite is allowed one parked vehicle, displaying a parking pass where it is easily seen. Do **NOT** park in the grass.
- 3. Any other parking arrangements must be approved by management.

### DAY GUESTS AND VISITORS

- 1. Guests and visitors must stop at the office and register.
- 2. Day guests must follow all the Campground rules and regulations.

# <u>CABINS</u>

- 1. Check in is at 2:00 PM & Check out is at 12:00 PM.
- 2. Must be 25 years old to reserve cabins. Campground reserves the right to refuse reservations to anyone.
- 3. Guest credit card on file will be charged a minimum \$50 fee if cabin is left in a dirty condition and /or to cover any damage to the cabin that occur during your stay.
- 4. NO PETS allowed in cabins.
- 5. **NO SMOKING** allowed in cabins.
- 6. Bedding, towels and dishware are not provided, please bring what you need. Towels, Sheets, Linens, and Pillows are available for rent at the Clubhouse.

# **GOLF CARTS**

- 1. Children under the age of 14 **MUST** be accompanied by a responsible person over the age of 16 years old.
- 2. Only seasonal Campers and handicapped guests may have an insured golf cart at the Campground.
- 3. Drivers must possess a valid driver's license.
- 4. The speed limit is 5 MPH. No driving any vehicle without headlights after dusk.
- 5. Golf cart passengers may ride on the golf cart seats only in accordance with manufacturer recommendations.
- 6. Golf carts must remain on appropriate roads. Please stay off grass and campsites.
- 7. Golf carts need to be parked from 11:00 PM 8:00 AM.
- 8. Golf carts must have site number on both sides.
- 9. Please stay off neighboring properties, including the subdivision Whispering Highlands.

10. No Whitetail Bluff rented golf carts allowed on trails.

#### **BE RESPECTFUL**

**Safety is our number one priority, so please follow the rules.** Anyone whose conduct is offensive or disorderly to our campers, guests, residents, management or employees will be required to leave the premises or restricted to their campsite. Management will make the final decision in an instance of offensive behavior. If this occurs and the individual refuses to leave, local authorities will be summoned, and trespassing charges will be filed. The individual may also be banned from the Campground, as the Campground is Private Property.

Campers must follow all state, county and federal laws. Authorities will be contacted to investigate illegal activities including; vandalism, disturbances and any kind of drug use. If Police or Sheriff respond to a location for any illegal activity, the Campground reserves the right to cancel the Seasonal Agreement or have overnight campers leave the premises. No refunds are given in these situations.

Campground reserved the right to make any new rules or changes to rules as needed.

### VIOLATORS of these rules may be asked to leave the Campground without refund.
